From Where I Sit . . .

“WHO IS JESUS? THE DISCERNER OF THE HEART”

John in his description of Jesus says something very interesting about His unique ability. Notice John 2: 23 - 25, “[23] Now when He was in Jerusalem at the Passover, during the feast, many believed in His name when they saw the signs which He did. [24] But Jesus did not commit Himself to them, because He knew all men, [25] and had no need that anyone should testify of man, for He knew what was in man.” John calls Jesus one who is a discerner of the heart of mankind. This means that Jesus knows each man in a very intimate, personal way. He knows our very innermost thoughts. He knows what we deem to be important. He knows what truly scares us. He knows what we desire. He knows our hopes and our dreams. He knows what we treasure. He knows what we seek. He also knows what troubles us and keeps us awake at night. He even know our weaknesses.

This intimate knowledge about mankind could only come from the One who created us. Notice these two important passages: John 1: 1 - 5, “[Jn 1:1] In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. [2] He was in the beginning with God. [3] All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made. [4] In Him was life, and the life was the light of men. [5] And the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it.”, and Colossians 1: 15 - 18, “[15] He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. [16] For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him. [17] And He is before all things, and in Him all things consist. [18] And He is the head of the body, the church, who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in all things He may have the preeminence.” Jesus created us so He knows us better than we even know ourselves. He also created us for Himself. This knowledge of even the smallest details of our heart allows Him to know how to be the Light that guides us to the place that He wants us to be, John 14: 1 - 4, “[14:1] “Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me. [2] “In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. [3] “And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also. [4] “And where I go you know, and the way you know.”

This statement concerning Jesus made by John also gives us some insight on how Jesus will judge us in the end. Jesus will not look upon our outward appearance. Nor will He look upon the accomplishments we have had in our life on this earth. He will not look upon the wealth nor the notoriety we have accumulated while living here on earth. No, He will evaluate us by what we treasure, what we seek, what we deem to be important, and what we have been doing with our lives. This is exactly what God told Samuel when He was looking for a king for Israel, I Samuel 16: 7, “[7] But the LORD said to Samuel, “Do not look at his appearance or at his physical stature, because I have refused him. For the LORD does not see as man sees; for man looks at the outward appearance, but the LORD looks at the heart.”

What does this mean to me? It means that I must be working to keep my heart in the right place. Jesus said it very simply in Matthew 6: 33, “[33] “But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.” Solomon also wrote a very concise way of making sure our heart is right, Ecclesiastes 12: 13 - 14, “[13] Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God and keep His commandments, For this is man's all. [14] For God will bring every work into judgment, Including every secret thing, Whether good or evil.” The greatest way to keep our heart right is to love as Jesus loved, John 13: 34 - 35, “[34] “A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another. [35] “By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another.”

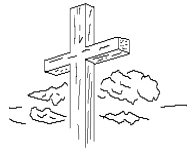
